

Joseph part 4, Famines and family


Big Game:

Romans 8:28


Even when things don't go the way we expected or planned, just like in the story of Joseph God is still with us and can help good come out of each and every situation!

THE BIG ACTIVITY

In our story today a silver cup was put into Benjamin's sack as a test. We are going to make our own precious piece of pottery to remind us of this part of the story.

You will need

Air drying clay, salt dough or play doh
Coloured sequins and beads

What you need to do:

1. Take a handful of air dry clay and roll it into a large ball.
2. Poke both thumbs into your ball to create a hole. Keep turning the ball in your hands while pinching with your fingers to widen the hole and flatten out your pot. Squash the pot onto a table to flatten the base.
3. Push beads or sequins into your pot to decorate, then leave to dry. Once it's all dry you could use some paints to paint your pot too!
